If your child has lost a piece of uniform, please check **LOST PROPERTY.**

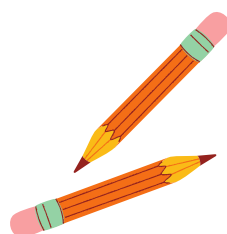

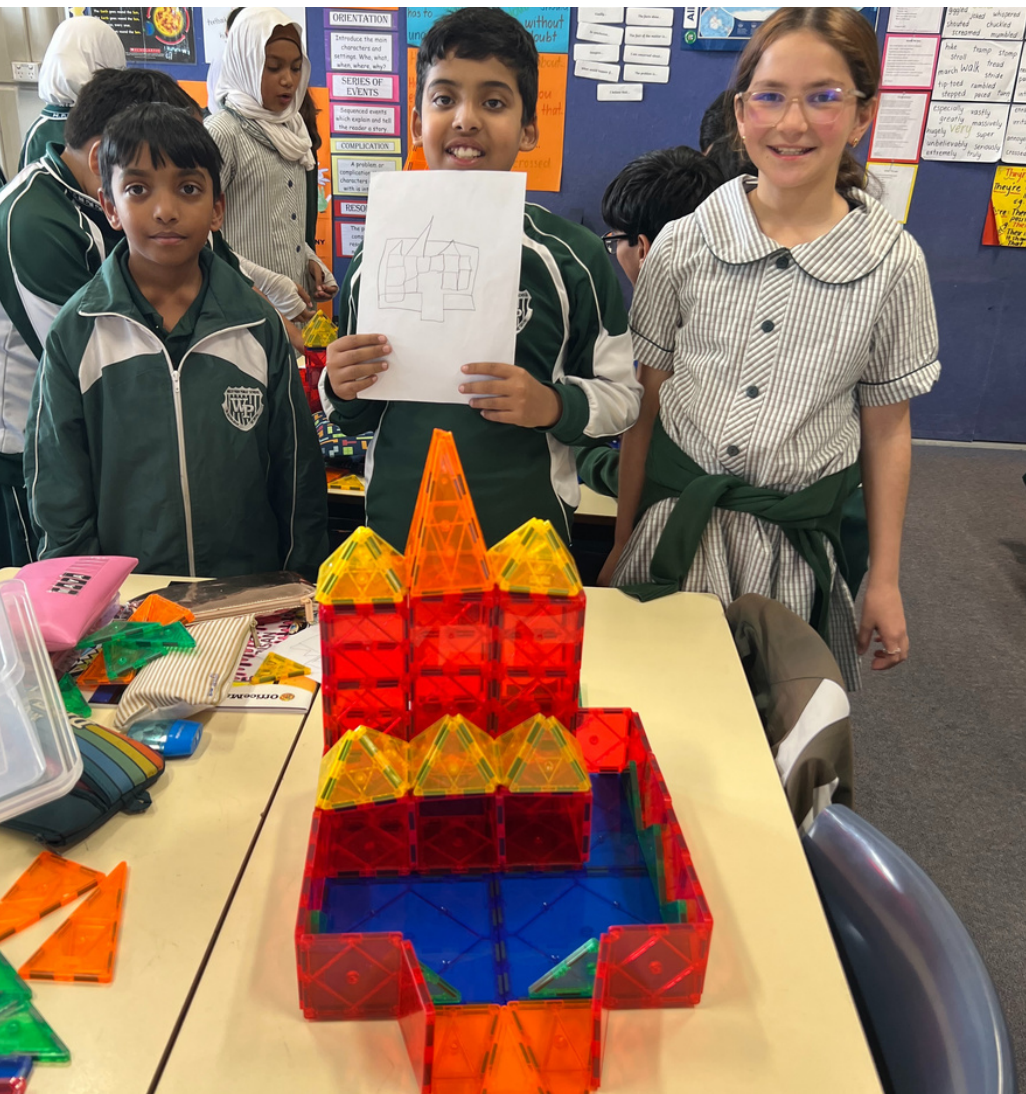

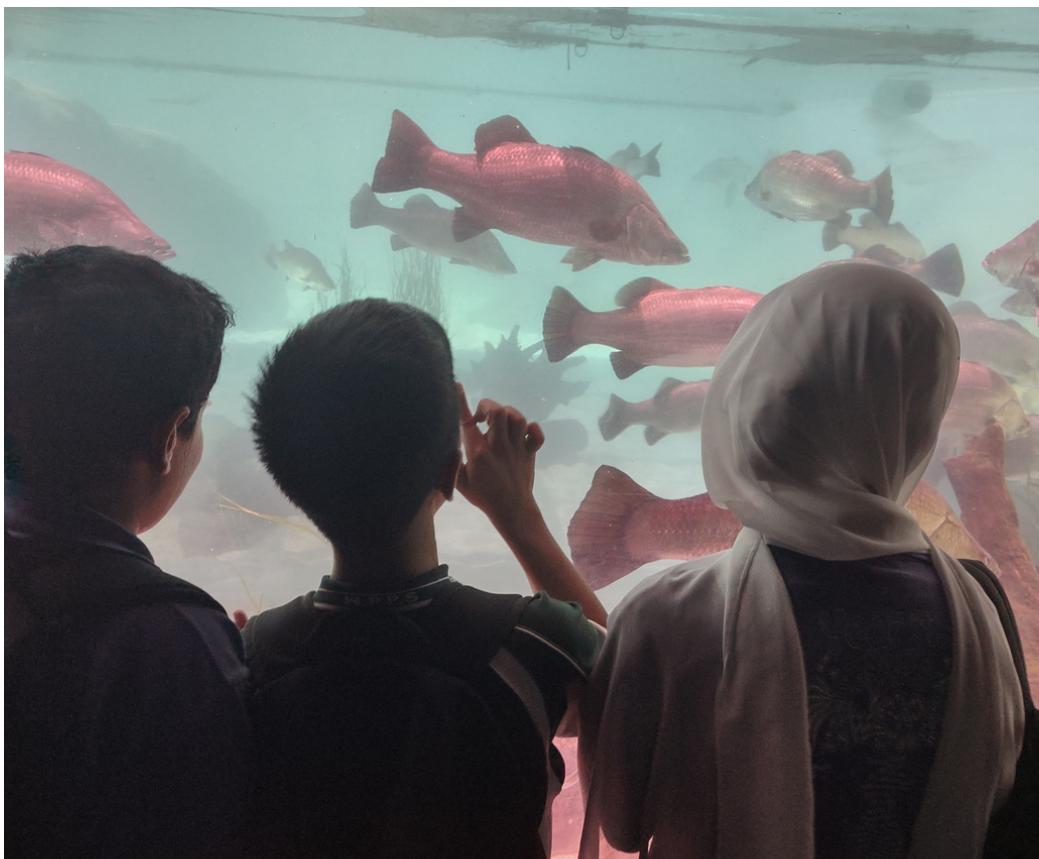

Winter

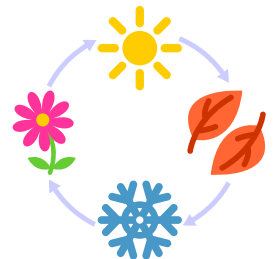
When it is winter I feel alone,

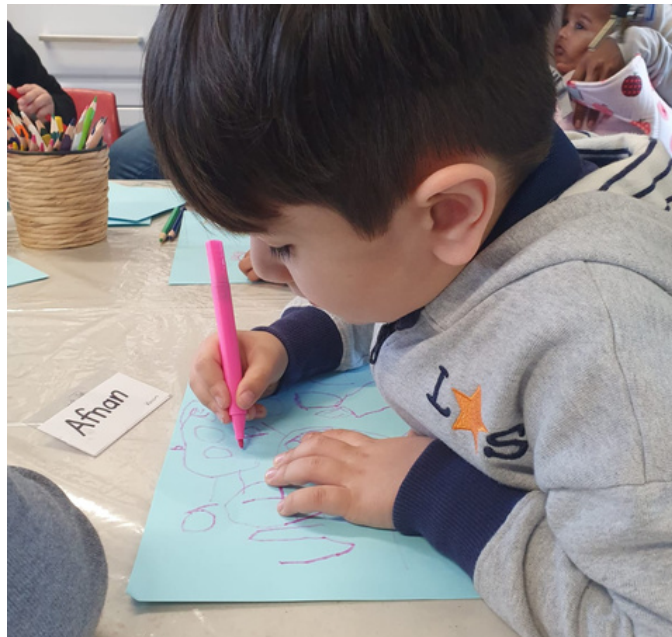
