Enrolments are now open for Kindergarten 2024.

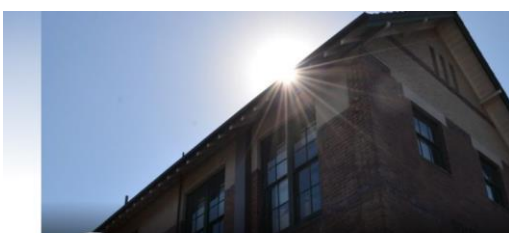
If your child is turning 5 Before 31 July 2024, they are now eligible to enrol for kindergarten 2024.
