The Reading Log is a record of your child's daily reading. After having completed the Reading Log students receive a ribbon at assembly to acknowledge their progress. Students must read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day.

- Where is the setting of the story? (Where does the story take place)
- ❖ What time of day does the story take place?
- ❖ Who are the characters in the story?
- ❖ Is there a problem in the story? If so, what is the problem?
- ❖ What is the solution to the problem in the story?
- Can you think of another solution?
- ❖ How do you think your solution will change the ending?
- ❖ What happens at the beginning, middle, and end?
- ❖ Did you like the story? Why or why not?
- Can you think of a different ending for the story?
- ❖ What would you do if you were in the story?
- ❖ Would you recommend this story to a friend? Why or why not?
